- I understand the following are unacceptable behaviors:
 - Cursing or verbally abusing anyone for any reason
 - Fighting, threatening, stealing, damaging property, or endangering the well-being of self or others

If I chose to exhibit unsuitable behavior, I may be sent home. My parents are responsible for picking me up. If my parent cannot be reached, then a person listed as an emergency contact may be called. Repeat offenders may be prohibited from attending events.
